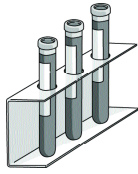
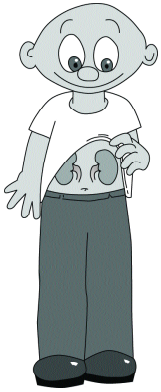


Additional Recommended Tests and Procedures



Creatinine (blood test)

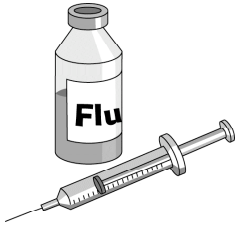
Measures how well your kidneys are working. This blood test should be done yearly.



Micro Albumin (urine test)

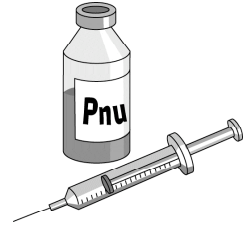
This is another test that measures how well your kidneys are working. This test should be done yearly.

Flu Vaccine



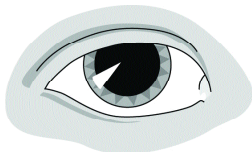
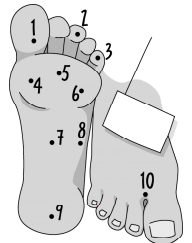
A yearly flu shot can help keep you healthy during the flu season. A pneumonia vaccine at the age of 60 and another one every ten years after that is recommended.

Foot Exam

Feet should be checked at every visit with your health care provider to detect any loss of sensation and foot problems. A thorough exam using a monofilament should be done yearly.



Dilated Eye Exam

To detect eye problems early, a dilated eye exam should be done yearly.

Dental Exam

To prevent gum disease a dental cleaning every 6 months is recommended.
